1. 다음을 듣고, 여자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: [*Chime bell rings.*] Attention, everyone! Our CEO, Mr. Wayne, has prepared a snack bar to celebrate our success on last month's project. Please come down to the lobby and enjoy some delicious snacks. They'll be available until 4 p.m. You'll be impressed by the amazing variety, from crispy fries and hot dogs to fresh lemonade and coffee. It'd be great if you could bring your own personal cups for the drinks. See you there.
